WHAT TO BRING:

- **SHARPS** (hypodermic needles, syringes, etc.) – Must be in rigid, tight-sealing, capped container.
- **Expired or unwanted medications and drugs** (in original container)
 - **Veterinary medications**
 - **Vitamins**

*NOTE: It's permissible to use a marker to cross off your name on the prescription containers, but medication information must be legible.

This free event is a great opportunity for residents to clean out their medicine cabinets and bring all expired or unwanted medications and SHARPS, for proper disposal, with the added benefit of keeping these materials out of the waste stream. Unwanted medications should never be disposed of in the toilet or down the drain.
