The Bidding Documents may be purchased at the Light Plant Office upon payment by cash, money order, cashiers' check or certified check of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each set requested. Checks shall be made payable to the Town of Concord. Purchase price will not be refunded.

The project shall be substantially completed on or before October 23, 2009. Work in all areas is to be completed and ready for final payment, in accordance with paragraph 14.13 of the General Conditions, on or before November 13, 2009.

A pre-bid conference will be held in the Concord Municipal Light Plant conference room at 1175 Elm Street in Concord, MA on July 29, 2009, beginning at 2:00 p .m.

Bid security in the amount of 5 percent of the Bid must accompany the Bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall note that no less than the prevailing wage rates as set forth in the Contract Documents shall be paid on this Project. Attention is also called to the requirements relating to Workman's Compensation, Conditions of Employment, and the Equal Employment Opportunity, Anti-Discrimination, Affirmative Action Programs.

The Concord Municipal Light Plant reserves the right to waive irregularities or informalities and to reject any and all Bids as may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Light Plant.
