A public forum to discuss the most recent concept plan for a proposed park project that consists of 8.11 acres of land bordered by the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail to the southwest, the Assabet River to the east and the MCI Correctional Institute to the north. The project is divided into two parcels: a 1.43-acre flat, smaller wedge of land on the left (northwest) side of the property, and 6.68-acre long, thin, largely wooded piece of land along the riverbank. The parcel is owned by the Concord Housing Development Corporation, which is developing another 4+ acres on site between the two parcels of the project area, for an 83-unit affordable assisted living facility. In 2020, Concord's Select Board created the Junction Village Open Space Task Force (JVOSTF) to develop a master plan for the open space portion of the site. This group's charge is to establish a plan that includes passive recreation on the site, and that takes advantage of its central location, natural landscape, and historical significance. The April 6 public forum is to detail changes to a plan first presented to the public on Oct. 14, and to seek public feedback in advance of Town Meeting.
