**Administrative business:**

1/ A public forum to discuss two concept plans for a proposed park project that consists of about 6.5 acres of land bordered by the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail to the southwest, the Assabet River to the east and the MCI Correctional Institute to the north. The project is divided into two parcels: a flat, smaller wedge of land on the left (northwest) side of the property, and a long, thin, largely wooded piece of land along the riverbank. The parcel is owned by the Concord Housing Development Corporation, which is developing another 4+ acres on site between the two parcels of the project area, for an 83-unit affordable assisted living facility. In 2020, Concord's Select Board created the Junction Village Open Space Task Force (JVOSTF) to develop a master plan for the open space portion of the site. This group's charge has been to establish a plan that includes passive recreation on the site, but that also takes advantage of its central location, natural landscape and historical significance. The Oct. 14 public forum is to present the fruition of that plan.
