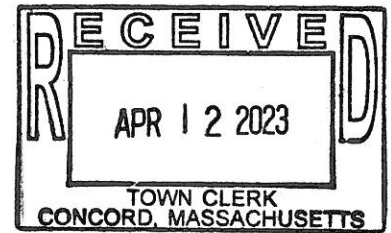


250th ART, LITERATURE AND MUSIC SC
