

	<ul> <li>Janet- high school students; work with faculty sponsor of Green Team (Priscilla Guiney) – kids need a 2-3 week window and they should get community service</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Need more info on when to collect the seeds (likely different times for different plants)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Let's pick 3 plants to focus on this year, just to get going.</li> <li>Try to get advice from others- SVT task force? Brian?</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Could also ask community garden members to help</li> </ul>
