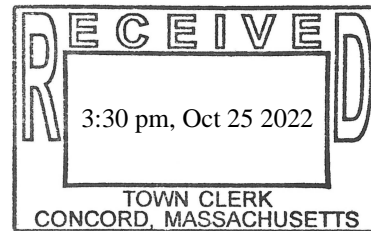


**CIVIL WAR MONUMENT TASK FORCE
MINUTES OF MEETING
September 13, 2022
Concord Museum, 53 Cambridge Turnpike**



Beth Van Duzer reported on the timetable for submitting an application to the Community Preservation Committee for funding to absorb the cost of a new tablet for the Civil War Monument recognizing and honoring G.W. Dugan as Concord's 49th fallen Civil War soldier. Should the CPC approve funding, the Task Force will seek, select, and recommend a firm to create and install the tablet and preserve and conserve the monument.

A motion was made by Beth to pursue funding under the Community Preservation Act. The motion was voted upon and approved.

With the CPC proposal in the pipeline and allowing sufficient time for the review process, the Task Force has identified Memorial Day 2024 as a set aside date for a tablet/monument dedication ceremony.
