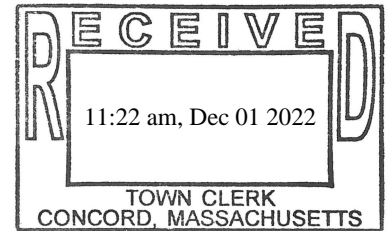


Concord 2025 Executive Committee

1. Administrative Items

- a. Call to Order: 4.00 pm – a quorum being present.
- b. Reed Gochberg moved to accept and approve the August 23, 2022, Concord 2025 Executive Committee, History & Education Subcommittee minutes. Bob Furey seconded the motion. The committee unanimously voted to approve the minutes.

2. Discussion / Possible Action Items

  - iii. Develop list of sources and schools to take part in a 2024 summer curriculum workshop – **Susan Foster** to report more in November.
  - iv. Host an “*In Their Words*” event. Needs more research.
- c. New Ideas
  - i. Create a public history program using the GIS War Stores Map. Committee agreed it is worth pursuing.

- ii. Look into bringing David Brown's Company to Concord for weekend of April 19, 2025. **David Wood** to question Executive Committee regarding honoraria.
