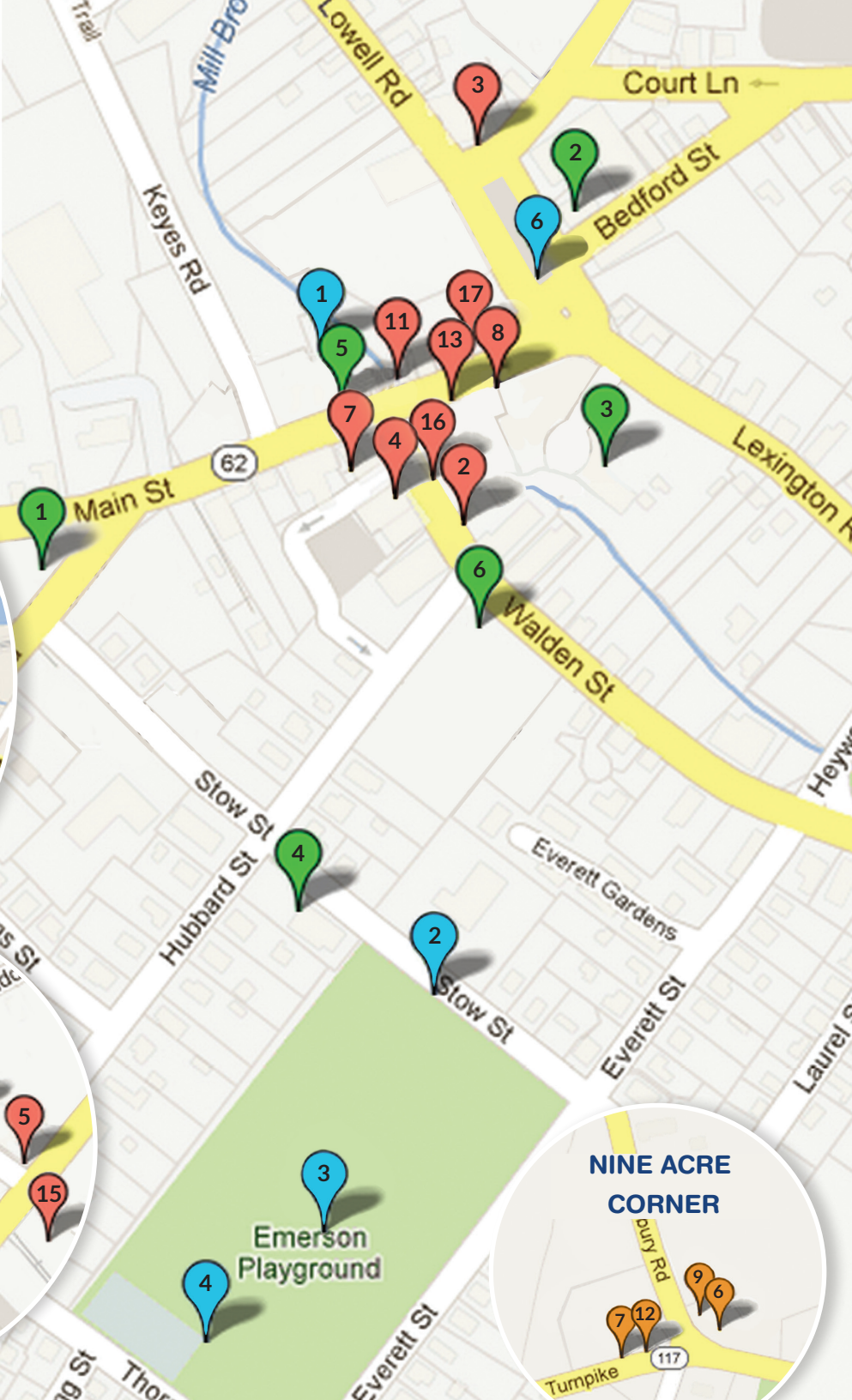
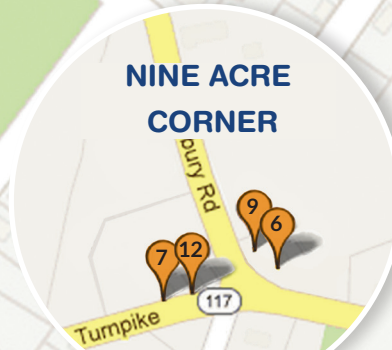
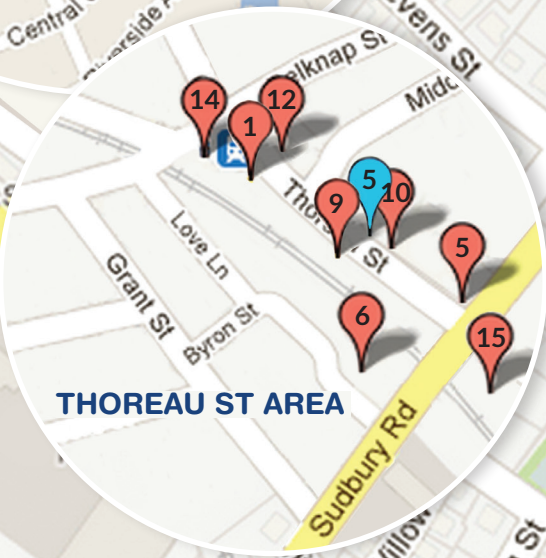
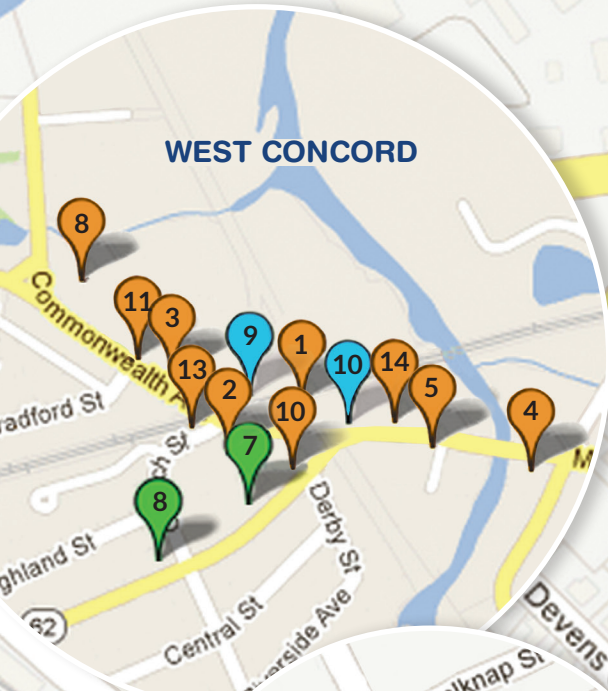
Our Community's Choice
