Mr. Lambert moves:

That the Town take affirmative action on Article 3 as printed in the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting of April 14, 2015.

- Has been voted annually at Town Meeting since 2001.
- A local decision to double (increase by100%) the value of property tax exemptions set forth in state statute (MGL Ch. 59, §5).
- New state law (Chapter 62 of the Acts of 2014) makes this provision a one-time Local Acceptance Statute.
- Only a change in percent would require future Town Meeting action; 100% increase is maximum allowed.

- 89 eligible taxpayers in FY2014
- \$96,545 charged to Overlay account
- State reimbursement rec'd in FY14: \$36,970
- State does not share in the local decision to increase the value of the exemption

Example:

- clause 41C state law provides for a \$500 exemption for eligible taxpayers
- Vote under Article 3 increases this to \$1,000
- Refer to the handout for eligibility details; also on town website at concordma.gov
