



FITCHBURG COMMUTER RAIL LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATE

Construction Advisory **Main St. (Rt. 62) Bridge Replacement Project** **Road Closure - Saturday August 1st**

As the MBTA and its contractor on the Fitchburg Main Line Improvement project proceed with improvements to the commuter rail line from Boston to Fitchburg, abutters in Concord can expect traffic delays on Main Street, (Route 62) as single lane closures continue to be employed over the next several months to allow for the new railroad bridge to be constructed over the road.

Single lane closures are expected to continue as needed through Fall 2015.

Additionally, Main Street is scheduled to be closed at the bridge THIS SATURDAY AUGUST 1st from approximately 6am to 8pm to complete work began but not completed during last weekends closure. The project anticipates only a one day closure this weekend but will continue work into Sunday (8/2) if needed to complete this work.

Finally, a total closure of the road is scheduled to be in effect from August 26th through September 2nd to roll in the new bridge structure.

Access to all local residences will be maintained during construction. Variable message boards and police details will be utilized to support the single lane closures. The full road closures will employ detour signage, variable message boards, and Police details to support the detours in effect during these two temporary road closures.

We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause. These are once in a lifetime improvements essential to the rehabilitation of the Fitchburg Line. Customers can look forward to significant service improvements when this improvement project is completed.
